## 〈重蹈覆轍的反思〉

兒時的我,不懂得甚麼是欺凌,認為那只是朋友間打鬧之詞。長大過後,我才了解那並不如我心中所想。中學時 期,即使同學之間偶有爭執,我也以自己只是一介學生,沒有理會太多,只想做好本份。後來,同學之間的矛盾越來越 大,有人認為是同學甲撩事生非在前,同學乙才反抗;但也有人持相反看法。當時我沒有理會太多,心想:與其花時間 在吵鬧之上,倒不如用來溫習課本。直到後來同學甲多次缺席我才知道,原來她是社會關愛基金受助者,一直被同學嘲 笑,甚至有人在午飯期間把食物潑在她身上,她上廁所時,又有人把廁所門封上,再倒洗地水在廁格內,原來她一直受 了不少委屈……我知道這些事後很生氣,她只想正常過生活,就被那些有「權力」和「背景」的人嘲笑和玩弄。我當時 的心態很自私,雖然認為欺凌行為不對,卻沒有為她取回公道。原來同學乙的媽媽給了學校不少好處,連校長也對她退 避三舍,既然學校也只是睜一隻眼,閉一隻眼來處理同學甲乙之間的紛爭,那麼,我又何必多事呢?從那時開始,這份 悔疚能一直藏在我心上,即使是弱勢社群,也不應受到不公平對待的。如今,如果我再相遇同學甲的話,我真想對她說 一聲抱歉,從前我選擇沉默,選擇了對不公義的事視而不見,實在十分自私,同時,我也希望這些事件不會再次發生。

大學畢業後,我找到一份工作,是在一所名校當代課老師。這所名校的學生個個品學兼優,從來沒有任何負面新 聞,所以我很喜歡這份優差,一切都很美好。直到某天晚上,我忘了帶重要的文作回家,所以返回辦公室取文件,誰知 當我在走廊經過的時候,我看見對面教學樓天台上有一堆學生,仔細地看清楚才發現他們在搞「弱者擂台戰」,當時我 以為是學會活動,沒有多想,加上我是新老師,不敢隨便判定他們是不是私下集結。第二天回校授課時,我看見其中一 個同學臉部有明顯傷勢,我便上前查問,他說因為單車剎車器壞了,所以跌倒受傷,那時全班的目光注視着我,我對他 說下次要小心一點,對話就此結束,但我知道這些傷痕根本不是因跌倒而造成的,畢竟我也是騎單車 上班下班

,我清楚知道跌倒是甚麼樣子。為此,我向其他老師查詢該如何處理,但其他老師勸我不要多管閒 只是代課老師,不需要太過執著。

後來,那位同學退學了,所有同學臉上都表達了一副事不關己的樣子,我嘗試問周邊的人, 沒有人知道他為甚麼退學,直至新聞報道某名校一名高中男生在家中燒炭自殺身亡,圖片上雖打了 馬賽克,但我還是認出來了。他就是那位退學學生,其後報道內容指他家境貧窮,憑着自身優異 的成績入讀名校,但有同學因妒成恨,長期欺凌他,最終他忍受不住而在家中自殺,其遺書 内容也說明了一切。

我當時淚如泉湧,因為我讓他受到委屈,甚至因而自尋短見。為 甚麼當時我不追查下去呢? 也許我能開解他……想不到自己又再犯 了相同的錯誤,沉默沉默也是一種罪啊!為甚麼我讓不公義的事情 發生?沒有主動協助那些受委屈的人?我內心一直反問自己,也不斷 反思自己過往種種行為。

十年過後,這兩件事對我來說,仍然令我耿耿於懷,我十分後悔自己當初的決定, 假如時光能倒流,我必定不會再重蹈覆轍。

## 重蹈覆轍的反思



錯誤每個人都會犯,但相同的錯誤再犯在人們眼中 便不可輕恕。犯錯者心裏有更深愧疚感的同時,重蹈覆 轍背後可能另有原因。

我的成長過程中一直有姐姐相伴,閃現眼前的是一幕溫馨的畫面,但事實總是殘酷的,我小時候總愛調皮 搗蛋,對於年長我一歲的姐姐有着羨慕但嫉妒的情感。 這羨慕之情就誘發了我同一個錯誤一犯再犯。

姐姐在家中獲得的寵愛比我多,有漂亮的衣服裙子 姐姐總能搶佔先機獨享,我只能待姐姐不合適了,我長 個了才可擁有。沒辦法,家中有兩個孩子,孩子身體長 得快,大的不合適小的接着穿是一種養孩子的智慧。年 幼時的我就成了「二攤店」的主人,專穿姐姐退下的衣 服。俗話說得好,「人的忍耐是有限度的」。一天媽媽 給姐姐買了一條帶亮片的粉紅迷你裙,我看得雙眼直冒 光, 愛美之心從小女孩時期便萌生, 賊心一起, 我便在 某個姐姐去上興趣班的下午,「偷」到了那條迷你裙, 想着獨自「享用」一番,再偷偷放回原處。但是意外發 生了,姐姐長個兒長高了腰更為纖細,而我體內積聚的 脂肪因為懶惰並沒有因為成長有所減少,肚腩周圍還有 一圈肉,在我把裙子從大腿往上拉的那一刻,「呲啦」 一聲,裙子邊上的綫開了,裙子開了一道大口子。姐姐 發現新買的裙子壞了後,憤怒無比,我毫無疑問被媽媽 「修理」了一頓。但體驗到了穿新裙子的滋味,方法有 誤但目的達到了。

這兩次經歷中每次都受到了姐姐和父母的嚴厲批評與「懲罰」但我那時的真正需求與目的他們並不知道,從道德層面上他們的做法很正確,但卻沒站在我的角度思考。我還小不大會表達,家人比較寵愛姐姐,我獲得的關注與她相比少得多,享用新東西的機會在我的童年少之又少。對於成長的我有一股迫切,體驗成長的感覺成為了我犯錯的動機,同時也是我的一種表達方式,渴望得到父母的關注,可以快快長大,體驗長大的感覺,減少束縛,走更寬闊更長的路。

重蹈覆轍在很多人眼中情況很嚴重,很惡劣,人往 往選擇責備,較少了解犯錯者背後的原因。其實在我背 後最初只是一個小萌芽,是一個純真無邪的動機,在沒 有理解與輔助成長下,獨自利用一切的資源在沒有設計 好的軌道上生長,結出的果有好有壞,好壞的定義是甚 麼,不同的人有不同的標準,取決於你是否真正了解背後 的原因,真正的需求是否被知道與滿足。重蹈覆轍背後有 所延伸,你所選擇的解決方式會帶來不一樣的結果。

自此之後,我總算明白「失敗乃成功之母」這句話 的意義,雖然吸收失敗的教訓不能確保下次一定成功, 但如果沒有經歷失敗,成功將更遙不可及。
