I am writing to talk about the water management in Hong Kong. It has already become a serious issue which deserves our attention. Many countries also have problems about water management, but they apparently handle them better than we do. In the following, I would like to mention two cases which may give insights to our government.

First, let's take a look at Britain's situation. They have a nice idea to tackle the flooding issue: flood barriers. These barriers are safe to use because they are self-activated. They can keep the flood water away from residential areas. Flood barriers have been in use in Britain for many years. I think our government should learn from them.

Second, Singapore has been facing water shortage. They have limited water resources but a large population. To solve this problem, they invented "NEWater". NEWater is actually sewage that is recycled for use. It is cheap but its quality is as good as tap water. NEWater is not only used for industrial and commercial uses, but also drinking and crop watering. Now, NEWater contributes to 40 percent of Singapore's water supply. If our government learns from Singapore, we may not have to buy Dongjiang water anymore.

In conclusion, I think the Hong Kong government should really consider adapting the technologies mentioned above if they want to manage water resources well.


